- 1) New Boston has a **Mandatory** Town recycling policy, approved by Town vote in 1993. Your trash may be inspected to ensure compliance. Your access to the facility to deposit your trash and recyclables may be revoked if you do not adhere to this mandatory recycling policy.
- 2) Clear or Transparent trash bags only.
- **3)** Chemicals, Paints of ANY KIND, pesticides or Hazardous Material <u>CANNOT</u> be accepted at the Transfer Station. Please see staff for proper disposal procedure.
- **4)** Fee based items can be paid for by <u>Cash, Checks or Credit</u> <u>Cards (3.99% fee)</u> at the time of transaction. Signed receipts are required for all transactions.
- 5) Residential Permits are required.
- **6)** Temporary permits are required for contractors bringing New Boston Generated materials only.
- **7)** Food Waste Composting Program.

GREEN, CLEAR, BROWN, FROSTED, BLUE, CERAMIC, PLATES, CUPS and POTTERY.

(NO WINDSHIELDS, TILE, WINDOW GLASS, MIRRORS OR LIGHT BULBS OF ANY KIND)

#### **ALUMINUM BEVERAGE CANS**

BEVERAGE CANS ONLY.

<u>Pet food cans or foil goes in with the tin can bin.</u>

#### **TIN CANS**

PET FOOD, DRY <u>EMPTY</u> PAINT, FOIL ITEMS, TIN AND <u>EMPTY</u> AEROSOL CANS.

#### **CARDBOARD OCC**

ANY CLEAN, DRY, BROKEN-DOWN CARDBOARD ALL PRINTED, COLORED AND SHINY CARDBOARD

#### **MIXED PAPER**

ALL CLEAN PAPER, JUNK MAIL, MAGAZINES, PHONE BOOKS (hard covers removed),
CEREAL BOXES, EGG CARTONS, AND FOOD BOXES.
Keep shredded paper in bag and toss in window.
PLEASE NO REFRIGERATOR, SODA, BEER, COOLER PACK, FOIL COVERED OR SOILED PLATES OR SOILED TISSUES.
PLEASE Place in the trash

#### **HDEP #2 BOTTLES**

OPAQUE OR SOLID COLOR PLASTIC <u>BOTTLES</u> ONLY PLEASE REMOVE CAPS

#### **PETE #1 BOTTLES**

CLEAR OR SEE-THRU PLASTIC <u>BOTTLES</u> ONLY PLEASE REMOVE CAPS

#### METAL RECYCLING

No trash, Pressure tanks, electronics, tires, propane tanks, freon or hazardous items.
Oil tanks must be cut in half and clean.
ALL FLUIDS (GASOLINE, OIL, FUEL OIL) must be removed before depositing items into the metal recycling container.
