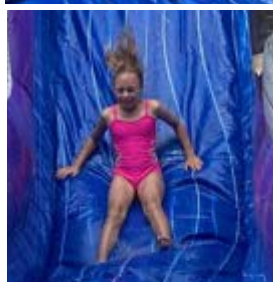
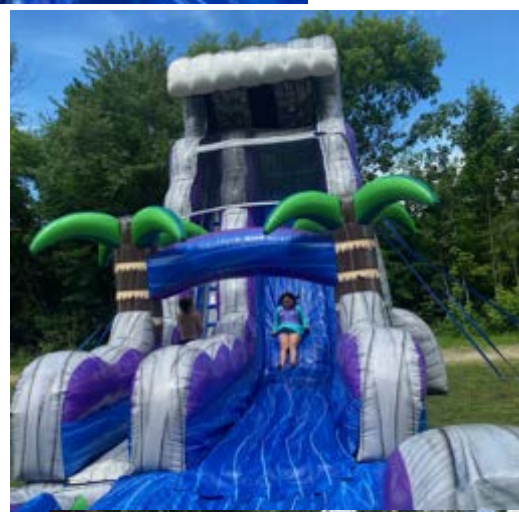

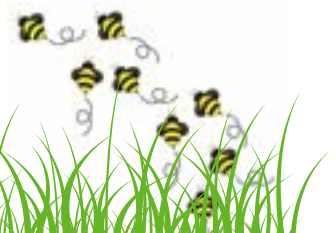


WEEK 1 TEAM CHAMPS! - THE BASEBALL BROS, TEAM LEADER—AURORA
