New Boston Transfer Station Residential / Commercial Policy

New Boston Transfer Station is a residential Transfer Station (RSA 149). The primary purpose is to provide a means for household disposal and recycling for residents of New Boston. Local Business or Commercial entities are not considered residential. All materials that come from the running of the business are not covered by taxation for disposal and can be disposed of by fee to cover cost into the bulky waste disposal category, if it is acceptable by vendor contract agreement. The New Boston Solid Waste Permit requires that all materials brought to the facility must be generated in New Boston. Recycling is required. Commercial Trash Haulers may access the facility after signing the responsibility agreement and following facility rules and regulations. Materials must be generated in New Boston.

Temporary Use Permit

How to Obtain a Temporary Use Permit for the New Boston Transfer Station and Recycling Center. These permits are available at the Town Hall, Select Board Office, during normal business hours.

The property owner or the contractor may come in to obtain a temporary and limited use permit for the Transfer Station. There is no cost to obtain a temporary use permit.

Fee rates for the disposal of demolition and debris are posted on the web site.

Written, signed permission from the property owner requesting that the contractor be allowed the use of the facility to dispose of residentially generated demolition and/or debris will be required. A temporary permit will then be issued.

The permit will contain the following information:

- · Resident's Name and address.
- Contractor's Name, business address and phone number.
- Dates of permitted use.

The contractor must present the permit at the Transfer Station to be allowed use of the facility.
