How to Obtain a Residential Use Permit for the New Boston Transfer Station

New Boston residents may obtain a sticker at no cost at the Transfer Station during normal hours of operation. Please be aware that some items will be charged a <u>fee</u>.

Please bring current New Boston vehicle registration or if you are a new resident, please provide proof of residency by showing a lease/rental agreement, purchase and sales agreement or a copy of utility bills.

You must display an official New Boston Transfer Station sticker on your vehicle to utilize the facility.

Non-permanent, resident property owners with Out of State registered vehicles, will be issued a non-resident property owner (NRPO) sticker.

How to Obtain a Temporary Use Permit for the New Boston Transfer Station

Temporary Use Permits are available at no cost at the Town Hall Select Board's Office during normal business hours. Please be aware that some items will be charged a <u>fee</u>.

Written, signed permission from the property owner requesting that the contractor be allowed the use of the facility to dispose of residentially generated demolition and/or debris will be required. A temporary permit will then be issued.

The permit will contain the following information:

- Resident's Name and address.
- Contractor's Name, business address and phone number.
- Dates of permitted use.

The contractor must present the permit at the Transfer Station to be allowed use of the facility.
